Volunteer Positions & Descriptions:

Social Media Marketing Manager

Develops and implements the organization's social media strategy, including marketing plans that leverage social media outlets. Responsible for development and maintenance of online content that attracts attention, generates interest, and is easily shared with social networks. Establishes relationships with bloggers and other members of the online community.

Social Media Graphic Designer

Perform other duties, as assigned

Under general supervision, a highly motivated and highly creative digital/web/social media designer will work with the Creative Director to design various social media graphics for marketing purposes. Primary responsibilities and duties include: Assist with design of social media posts, web page graphics, infographics, and print material Design delivery across a wide array of experience types including gestures, touch, mobile and print Assist with collateral production such as applications, blogs, web sites, videos and presentations Support multiple projects simultaneously Stay up-to-date in the Social Networking world Support the team with your knowledge of HTML, CSS, and Adobe Creative Suite Utilize project plans to execute initiatives and campaigns on schedule Assist with marketing and scheduling of social media posts

Partnership Liaison

Develop strategies to expand Sydney's Book Club cross/cause marketing campaign.

Develop corporate prospecting plan, sales materials and lead pitch presentations to secure additional partners.

Build partnerships with a focus on raising funds for SBC mission and programs.


Resource Developer

Develop individual fundraising activities that individuals or groups may get involved in to raise awareness and financial support of the SBC mission.

Grant Writer

Grant Writer would be responsible to research, identify and respond to grant opportunities which meet the needs of SBC, seeing the grant proposal through from start to finish.

Prepare, submit and manage grant proposals.

Perform prospect research on foundations and corporations to evaluate prospective grants.

Comply with all grants as required by corporate/foundation donors.

Establish and maintain good rapport with current donors.

Maintain accurate records in database of all grants and donations.

Track statistics relevant to development and report metrics and data to donors as needed.

Social Media Guru

Social Media Volunteer Responsibilities (include but are not limited to the following): Monitor organizations accounts and mentions on various social platforms, including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Tumblr, and others

Assist in scheduling and populating profiles

Explore the brainstorming and strategy processes of social media marketing

Track social media for emerging trends / stories and best practices

Manage regular profile updates and post history

If you're a person who is creative, artistic and very hands on this could be the position for you! We need individuals to produce/make customized/personalized preschooler literacy crafts. Your crafts will be used as a blog, added to our curriculum, and promoted via our social media! If you're up to this creative challenge, we can't wait to hear from you!

Virtual Volunteer Requirements and Time Commitment:

We ask that you commit to a minimum of 3-5 hours per month, for a minimum of six months. All virtual positions are work at your leisure as long as you meet the needs of the project and their specific deadlines. Positions will require computer, computer equipment, some design software, and other specific requirements are noted in position description.

Volunteer Orientation, Training and Requirements (Direct opportunities):

To fully support our volunteers and ensure their success, we require they attend a local book club event in which they will receive firsthand experience. You must attend an event before reading and the hosting is allowed.

Direct opportunities, specific days and times will vary based on your availability and the site's specific needs.

- Ability to read aloud books with character
- Be able to pass criminal background
- Have dependable transportation and valid licenses
